Lesson Five: Gifts of Healings

I. DEFINITION:

- A.** “Gifts.” Notice that the first term is plural.
- 1.** Unfortunately, many English translations do not render this as plural.
 - 2.** However, the Greek NT has *charismata*, which is the plural of *charisma*.
 - 3.** I take this to mean that healing occurs in a variety of ways:
 - a.** In answer to prayer
 - b.** By the spoken word
 - c.** By laying on of hands
 - d.** Anointing with oil
 - e.** By extraordinary means
- B.** “Healings.” Notice that this term is also plural.
- 1.** The word in the Greek NT is *iamaton*, which is the plural of *iama*.
 - 2.** I take this to mean that there are various kinds or categories of healings:
 - a.** Physical healings/Deliverance from demonization:
 - (1)** Matthew 4:23-24
 - (2)** Matthew 8:16-17
 - (3)** Acts 10:38

- b. Healing of Soul and/or Spirit:
 - (1) Matthew 11:28-29
 - (2) Isaiah 53:4-6 (compare with 1Peter 2:24-25)
